Dr. Libby Sallnow and dr. Afsan Bhadelia join us to talk about the Lancet Commission report on the Value of Death. Death, dying, and loss are universal human experiences, but the contention of the Lancet Commission is that they have become unfamiliar, disconnected, and unbalanced.

Dr. Libby Sallnow (MD, PhD) is a palliative care consultant, honorary clinical senior lecturer at St. Christopher's Hospice and UCL (UK), and a public health palliative care researcher connected to the Vrije Universiteit Brussel. She is also a member of the European Association for Palliative Care Reference Group on Public Health & Palliative Care and the vice-president of the world association Public Health Palliative Care International.

Dr. Afsan Bhadelia (PhD) is a health systems and disparities researcher. She is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Public Health within the College of Health and Human Sciences at Purdue University. She is a member of multiple Lancet Commission, including the Lancet Commission on the Value of Death and the Lancet Commission on Cancer and Health Systems.
